

These rate schedules are furnished for your information and convenient reference. The complete rate schedule and rules and regulations pertaining to them are on file at the office of Willmar Municipal Utilities and are available for inspection.

BILLING

All bills are rendered monthly and are due upon receipt. If payment in full is not received at the WMU office by the due date printed on the bill, a late charge of 10% will be assessed on all remaining current charges.

DELINQUENCY, DISCONNECTION AND RESTORATION OF SERVICE

If any bill is unpaid after the due date, the customer shall be considered to be delinquent and services are subject to disconnection. A notice of possible disconnection will be printed on the utility bill. Approximately 7 days before the scheduled date of disconnection, a final notice will be prepared and mailed. Accounts subject to disconnection are those accounts receiving a final notice which have not paid or have not made arrangements to pay prior to the date of termination of service on the notice. Accounts will not be disconnected on a Friday or the day before a holiday. Service will be restored on business days between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. after receipt of the total amount owing on the bill plus a restoration service charge.

DEPOSITS

Cash deposits are required from renters or lessees prior to providing utility service. Deposits on record shall earn interest at an annual rate as determined by the Minnesota Department of Commerce. Interest accrued will be paid in December each year and applied to the December bill. Deposits are returned pursuant to the current WMU Operations Policy.

HEAT PUMP RATE=EHP

The rate for off-peak service shall be as follows:

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATE=ER

The rate for residential service shall be the sum of the fixed cost and the energy charge:

All kWh	\$0.123/kWh	\$0.104/kWh

OFF-PEAK RATE=EOP

The rate for off-peak service shall be the sum of the energy charge:

COMMERCIAL SERVICE RATE=EC

The rate for commercial service shall be the sum of the fixed cost and the energy charge:

THREE PHASE COMMERCIAL RATE <25kW=E3PH

The rate for three phase commercial shall be the sum of the fixed cost and the energy charge:

All kWh	\$0.126/kWh	\$0.107/kWh

CITY FRANCHISE FEE

There shall be added to all utility bills a "City Franchise Fee" to be calculated by applying a rate to be determined by dividing the total kilowatt hours (kWh) sold by WMU annually by the total intergovernmental transfer and street lighting costs incurred by WMU for the preceding calendar year to each customer kWh billed monthly for the next 12 month period.

LARGE POWER RATE >25kW AND <500kW

The rate for large power shall be the sum of the fixed cost, energy charge and demand charge:

INDUSTRIAL RATE >500kW

The rate for industrial shall be the sum of the fixed cost, energy charge and demand charge:

<u>Energy Charge</u>	<u>Summer</u>	<u>Non-Summer</u>
All kWh	\$0.064/kWh	\$0.057/kWh
Demand Charge	\$18.25/kW	\$15.75/kW

ELECTRICAL ENERGY ACQUISITION ADJUSTMENT=EAA

There shall be added to all electrical energy billed an energy acquisition adjustment. The energy acquisition shall be calculated pursuant to the following formula: The overall average cost of wholesale power and net transmission costs (transmission costs less transmission revenue) incurred above the weighted average cost established at the time of the current rate schedule.

SECURITY LIGHTING

WATER RATES=WR/WRMU/WC/WI

The rate for water service shall be the sum of the meter charge, consumption charge and fixed cost as follows:

SEWER RATES =SR/SC/SI

Sewer service is billed on behalf of the City of Willmar. The rate for sewer shall be the sum of the billing charge, usage charge and the meter charge (debt service charge) as follows:
